A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

During this past week, I shared with my local Augustinian community, our Parish Staff and our Parish Pastoral Council, that I will be leaving the parish as of July 1st. Let me put all that in context.

It is no secret I am 80 years old, that I have been here for 10 years and as you know, due to a fall, was away from the parish for seven weeks and still have ramifications from that fall.

It is extremely important to emphasize that our Provincial, Fr. Rob Hagan, OSA, and our Province are very committed to continue staffing the parish, the first foundation of the Augustinians in this country. I might add that the Archdiocese of Philadelphia is grateful and very supportive that we do continue to take responsibility for the parish.

There is a definite consensus that many good things have happened in the parish over the years. There is an equally definite consensus that there is a great deal of potential for new possibilities for the parish. This is an opportunity for the Augustinians and the parish to step back and dream of what the future of the parish might look like in our culture and society today.

The "general plan" is for an Augustinian to be made an administrator of the parish. He will not live here but will oversee the administrative details of the parish. At the same time, he will work with others in devising a pastoral plan on how the parish can best respond to the contemporary needs of the Church.

I know this all seems very vague and it is. This is also why it is very exciting because the future is "open ended" on what many very worthwhile endeavors can take place.


