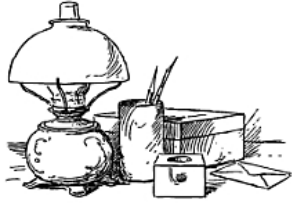

A word from Fr. Bill...

"Viva Santo Niño! Viva! Pit Señor!"

Dear Parishioners:

Next Sunday, we celebrate one of the highlights of our parish year, the Festival of Sinulog. This year is especially significant as it will be the 30th Anniversary of this celebration here at St. Augustine Parish, the National Shrine of Santo Niño. Also, our presider will be our newly elected Augustinian Provincial, Fr. Rob Hagan, OSA. This will be Fr. Rob's first visit to the parish as Provincial. He has been here often for weddings and baptisms. It is a great opportunity for him to experience the faith and enthusiasm of our Filipino community.

This celebration dates back to the sixteenth century when the image of Santo Niño (Holy Child or Child Jesus) was discovered at a house in the village of Cebú. The area had been destroyed by gunfire destroying 1500 homes and killing approximately 500 people. It was agreed that the image was brought from Spain. The Image was found inside a small pine box, preserved in almost perfect condition. It had on a little shirt and cap, two of its right hand's fingers were raised in a gesture of blessing, while the left hand held a globe symbolizing the world. This Image of the Child Jesus is the oldest surviving Catholic relic in the Philippines.

Interestingly, the image was brought in a solemn procession to a church in which the Augustinian Friars served. Consequently, the Augustinians and the Filipino community have had a close relationship for hundreds of years.

A church was built on the ground on which the image was found. It is very significant that during the last World War, a bomb fell inside that church but the Image of Santo Niño was found unscathed. It is one of the numerous miracles attributed to Santo Niño.

How appropriate it is that a parish community served by the Augustinian Friars will carry the image of Santo Niño in a solemn procession in our neighborhood next Sunday.

This celebration takes place in the Philippines on the 3rd Sunday of January but because of weather conflicts (cold and snow) we transfer the celebration here in Philadelphia to the 3rd Sunday of August. The church is always filled for this celebration, people coming from far and wide.

I invite all of our parishioners to participate in this very exciting, lively and faith filled celebration at 11:00 AM next Sunday. I invite you to participate in the procession and to share in refreshments and fellowship which will follow the procession. It is a true witness of our faith and it is a great opportunity for us as a parish community to come together to celebrate something joyful.

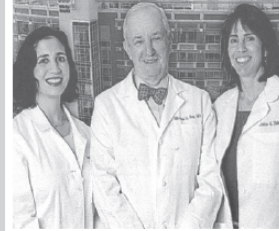

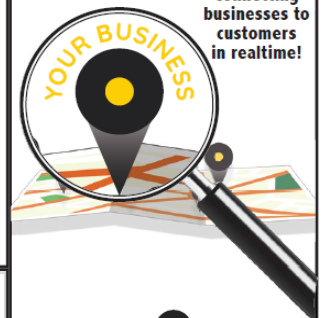
