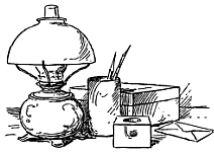

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

A few updates.

First, I would like to thank you for your generosity to the collection which took place two weeks ago for the people of Ukraine. The amount of this collection was approximately \$3,550, including a special \$500 donation which was made directly to the Sisters. This will help the cost for the Sisters to transport supplies and clothes to the people of Ukraine who are so drastically devastated by the war. Anyone who would like to help directly with packing the boxes, please be in touch with me for more details. Thank you again for your kindness.

As you know, this past Easter four new parishioners were fully initiated into the Catholic Church here at St. Augustine Parish. They participated in a process called RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. We will be beginning this process again this September. If you know anyone who has never been baptized, or someone who has been baptized into another Christian denomination, or someone who has been baptized Catholic but who never received First Communion or Confirmation, or someone who was baptized Catholic and received First Communion and would like to be confirmed, and if any of them would like to be fully initiated into the Church, please inform them of the process of RCIA and please ask them to be in touch with me. You also can refer them to the "Becoming Catholic" page of our parish website. Sometimes all someone needs is that invitation. Maybe you are the person God is using to invite them to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church.

I would like to welcome new tenants that we have here in the parish. Our Augustinian Province has decided to discontinue the Augustinian Volunteer Program. We have been very fortunate that the OSA volunteers in Philadelphia have made their home here at St. Augustine Parish for the past 16 years. Although we are sorry to see this program end, we are very happy to inform you that a group named **Vagabond Missions** will be using the space for various purposes including training and formation of their volunteers. It will be a home base of their Philadelphia operation. Who are they? The Vagabond Missions is a ministry where young people will be doing "street ministry" in Chester, Pennsylvania. Four young men and women will be living here and will be walking the streets of Chester making friends (like playing basketball, etc.) with some of the young people and inviting them to get to know Jesus and the Catholic Church better. They truly will be an asset to the Philadelphia community. We welcome them to our parish community. It is wonderful for us to be a small part of this endeavor. We assure them of our prayers and support for this very important outreach.

I mentioned in my letter in the bulletin last weekend that I would inform you of several Pregnancy Care Centers in the Philadelphia area who provide help before and after the birth of a child for women looking for an alternative to abortion. They provide counseling, medical attention, clothes, child care etc. The Family Life Office of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia has informed me of the following three local centers:

The Pro Life Union of Greater Philadelphia. Their website says "The Pro-Life Union uses hope and love for families to serve and accompany others by offering education, alternatives, and public witness that eliminates the need for abortion and euthanasia in Greater Philadelphia." 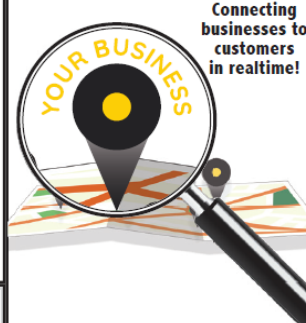
