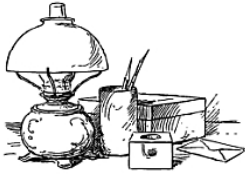

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

As you read this, I will be on retreat at the Jesuit Retreat House in Wernersville, PA. It is what is called a "seven-day directed retreat." It goes from this past Thursday until next Friday. I will meet with a director once a day, talking about what is going on in my life and with his help discerning where the Lord's presence is. Each day, depending on what we talked about, he will give me different scripture passages on which to reflect. The next day, I will meet with him and share the results of my reflections from the previous day and accordingly he will suggest another group of scripture passages on which to reflect. With the exception of meeting with him, the entire week is basically in silence. There will be others on retreat with whom we celebrate Mass and share meals, but in silence.

Please remember me in your prayers this week as I reflect on the Lord's presence in my life in the past, the present and the future. I will keep you in prayer as well. I will thank God for your encouragement and walking with me on this part of my journey, especially in the past two years.

Since the Fourth of July is being celebrated on Monday, July 5th, Mass on Monday, as on all federal holidays, will be at 10:00 AM instead of 12:05 pm.

As we do celebrate the Fourth of July, may we give thanks to God for our freedom, for those who sacrificed themselves that we can have freedom of religion. Our ancestors who wrote the Declaration of Independence had a spiritual vision. The word "God" is mentioned four times in the Declaration. They had the understanding that all people are created equal and that all people have a right to life and the pursuit of happiness. May we not take their vision and their values lightly.

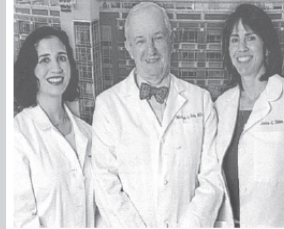
