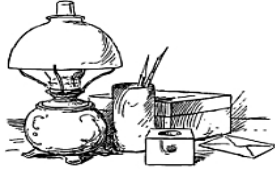

## *A word from Fr. Bill...*

Dear Parishioners:

Each year in June, the Augustinians of the East Coast (Province of St. Thomas of Villanova) meet for a week. This will take place this coming week from Sunday June 11 until Friday, June 16. This year it will be a mixture of business and retreat.

Since our Provincial Chapter last June, six different commissions have been meeting on a regular basis: a commission on the care of the sick and elderly, a commission on our relationship with other Augustinian Provinces, a commission on our relationship with our schools, College and University we serve, a commission on our relationship to the parishes we serve, a commission on the prophetic work of evangelization and social justice and the integrity of creation, and a commission on our response to a rapidly changing church and world.

Each of these commissions will give a 30-minute presentation on the work we have done in the past year and then there will be a 30-minute response from the members of the Province. This process will give the commissions thoughts and suggestions for the further development of recommendations that will be brought to the province membership for approval.

It certainly will not be a surprise that I have served on the commission reflecting on our relationship to parishes which we serve. Thanks to Zoom, four other friars and I have been able to meet six times in the past year. Keep me in prayer on Tuesday morning when I will be part of the presentation to our friars concerning our province's commitment to parish ministry.

As you can see, and as Pope Francis is encouraging, it is definitely a "synodal" process. Eventually, each commission will give specific recommendations in the vital areas of our province and ideally recommendations in which all of us have had input and "can own."

Obviously, we live in challenging times that affects our style of community life, all of our ministries, the care of our friars, and our response to new needs in the Church.

Please pray for us during these days of discussion on Monday and Tuesday.

On Wednesday and Thursday, we will enter into a retreat phase of our days together. We will have input from a guest presenter. There will be four talks and then opportunities for quiet time and group discussions.

During the week there certainly will be opportunities each day for communal prayer, celebration of the Eucharist, and meals together. We will be with brothers that we do not necessarily see that often.

The week will culminate on Friday morning when one of our friars, Michael Riggs, will be ordained a deacon.

It promises to be a very fruitful week. Please pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit on the various aspects of the week.

I am grateful to Fr. John Tumosa, who will be celebrating Mass here Sunday evening and each day this coming week.


