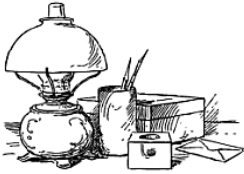

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

In my letter last week, I mentioned that three Augustinian Friars from our province are being ordained to the priesthood this Saturday (June 26) at St. Thomas of Villanova Chapel. The Bishop ordaining them is one of our own Augustinian Friars, Bishop Dan Turley, OSA, Bishop Emeritus of Chulucanas, Peru.

This is very encouraging for us as a Province and for the entire Church. It is encouraging in the climate of our society today to see men respond to God's call to the priesthood. It is encouraging because the Church is going to be served by three excellent, devoted, talented and creative men.

I would like you to meet them.

Bill Gabriel who is 28 is a graduate of Villanova University. He is from Dover, New Hampshire. Before he joined our community he taught at Archmere Academy in Claymont, Delaware. Bill spent a year teaching at Malvern Prep. This past year he has served as a Deacon at St. Thomas of Villanova Parish which is also where his first assignment as a priest will be.

Jeremy Hiers, 40, is originally from Hebron, Kentucky. Jeremy converted to Catholicism at age 29. He worked for the federal government for 12 years as an IT program manager and then joined our formation program. This past year he has served as a Deacon at St. Rita's Shrine in South Philadelphia which is where he also will begin his priesthood.

Elizandro Contreras who is 41 is originally from LaVega, Dominican Republic. After studying in the Dominican Republic, he spent time in Spain before coming to the United States and joining our formation program. He spent a ministerial year at St. Nicholas of Tolentine Parish in the Bronx. This past year Eli has served as a Deacon at St. Rita's Parish in Chicago. He is going to begin his priesthood ministering at the Christo Rey Philadelphia High School. This is the first year the Augustinians will be serving at Christo Rey. Eli will join 2 other Augustinians in this new adventure.

Bill, Jeremy, and Eli has been preparing for ordination for six years which has involved discernment, studying and ministerial work. They spent a year as pre-novitiate students, i.e., laypersons observing, participating and living in an Augustinian community. They spent a year as novices in Racine, Wisconsin learning about the charism of the Augustinians, the history of our Order and in-depth study of the vows which they were about to profess. At the end of the Novitiate year they professed vows of poverty, chastity and obedience for one year. They then began four years of study at the Chicago Theological Union for a Master's degree in Theology. After three years in temporary vows they professed solemn vows and then they were ordained deacons.

You can see how all three men have had very distinct and varied journeys, Bill starting in New Hampshire, Jeremy starting in Kentucky and Eli starting in the Dominican Republic, but on Saturday they will begin as Augustinian Friars to share together in the ministerial priesthood of Jesus.

Please join me in thanking God for the ordination to the Priesthood of these three fine friars. Please join me in praying that thru them Jesus will touch the lives of many people as they serve the Church as priests.

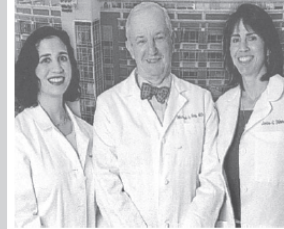
