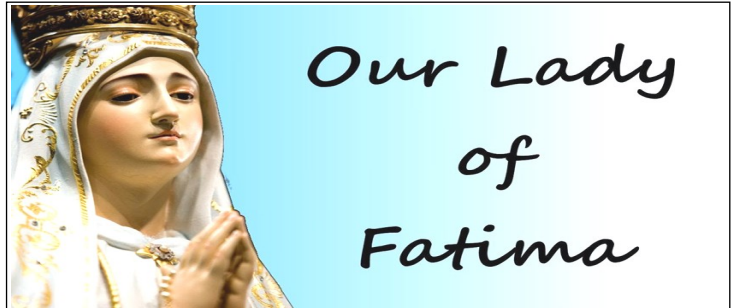

This year, October 20, 2019 marks a very special World Mission Sunday – our annual, worldwide Eucharistic celebration of our shared call to Mission.
