

A word from Fr. Bill....



Dear Parishioners:

At the 7:00 PM Mass this past Sunday we celebrated with five young men, "The Rite of Acceptance" which is part of the process of "The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" (RCIA) which as the name implies is the process which adults experience who are preparing to become Catholic. Let me put all this in context.

Matt Currier, Jerre Riggs, Zac Lowder, Alex Puhalua, and Gavin Villacorta have been meeting each Monday since September with Patrick Lanza and I in what is called "The Inquiry Stage," the initial period in the process of RCIA. During this time among other things they have inquired about the journey of faith, the meaning of the Mass, scripture, the role of the pope, bishops, priests, deacons and the laity, the saints, Mary, prayer and the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Having inquired, discussed and reflected on these topics and similar ones, Matt, Jerre, Zac, Alex and Gavin now with the "Rite of Acceptance" have moved into the next stage of the process. At the liturgy on Sunday they told the community they were seeking to grow in faith. They were introduced to the community by their respective sponsors and the parish community assured them of our prayers and support.

Matt and Jerre who have never been baptized are now officially "Catechumens" as they continue the process to receive all the Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, March 26th.

Zac who is called a "Candidate" has been baptized in another Christian community, a Baptist. As Zac continues in the RCIA process, he will make a Profession of Faith to the Catholic Church and then be confirmed and receive First Holy Communion at Easter.

Alex and Gavin who already have been baptized Catholics and have received First Holy Communion are presently preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

At our regular Monday gathering we all had an opportunity to share our impressions and insights into what we experienced on Sunday night at "The Rite of Acceptance." One of the Catechumens shared he felt a greater sense of comfort and welcoming. Another participant shared he was moved by the support of the larger community. My response was that the liturgy did what it was intended to do.

The RCIA process will continue until Pentecost in May for Matt, Jerre, Zac, Gavin and Alex. The highlight will be the actual celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter.

These men provide a real gift to us by being involved in this journey of faith with us. They are great witnesses that there are young people in our world and in our culture who are serious about the development of their faith and their relationship with Jesus through the context of the Catholic faith. This truly is encouraging.

Please join me in thanking God that they are taking this journey in the midst of our parish community. Please join me in praying that God will continue to bless them with their search for God and in their preparation to receive the Sacraments of Initiation.




